

# The Gee-Longest Kick on the Green Spine competition

## Terms and Conditions

Date: Sunday August 12, 2018

By entering into the Gee-Longest Kick on the Green Spine Competition (**Competition**), participants acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Competition will take place on Sunday, 12 August 2018 between 1pm and 2pm, commencing with a kick from available representatives from the Victorian Government and the City of Greater Geelong. These attempts will not be considered as part of the Competition but are for publicity purposes only.
2. One representative per AFL Barwon registered club, plus the Geelong Cats VFL and AFL teams, is eligible to participate. Clubs are to advise AFL Barwon of their nominated representative by 5pm, Wednesday 8 August 2018.
3. There will be a Gee-Longest Kick **men's category and women's category**.
4. The object of the Competition is to determine the representative from the men's category and women's category respectively that can kick a football the longest distance in accordance with these terms and conditions.
5. Representatives must be a currently registered player with the club they are representing and must wear their official football club guernsey.
6. Only chosen representatives of the AFL Barwon football clubs and the Geelong Cats VFL and AFL teams are eligible to compete in this Competition. Substitutes will not be eligible to participate unless advised by the relevant club in writing to AFL Barwon no later than 24 hours prior to the commencement of the competition.
7. The womens category will proceed the men's category.
8. Draw will be by club in alphabetic order.
9. Each representative will be entitled to two consecutive kicks, to be taken from behind the launch line at the synthetic grass surface on the crossing between Market Square Shopping Centre and Westfield Shopping Centre.
10. Each representative will have 60 seconds to complete their two kicks from when the representative's name is announced.
11. Kick is to be a drop punt.
12. The length of kick shall be measured from the launch line in clause 9 to the point where the football first lands, not where it finishes.
13. The football must land on the Malop Street roadway to be considered valid. Footballs landing in the bike lane or any area other than the roadway shall not be taken into account. In any event, for the avoidance of doubt, such kicks shall be considered as a kick for the purposes of clause 10.
14. The distance and legitimacy of the kicks to be judged by representatives from AFL Barwon Umpires.
15. Markers will be placed on the roadway to mark the furthest kick. Only the furthest kick will be marked.
16. Representatives warrant they have sought all necessary medical advice, are medically fit to participate, and participate at their own risk.
17. Footballs will be supplied by AFL Barwon for the competition. Representatives will not be permitted to use their own footballs.
18. The umpires' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
19. Prizes in the women's and men's category respectively are as follows:
  - \$500 to be paid to the winner's club;

- Revitalising Central Geelong Gee-Longest Kick trophy will be presented to each of the winners;
  - Winner of each category will receive a dinner voucher for two at the Rook : Sri Lankan Fusion birthday celebration on either Friday 24 August 2018 or Saturday 25 August 2018;
  - Trophies and meal vouchers are not transferrable and not redeemable for cash.
